Affordable Housing

To be considered affordable, a household should spend no more than 30 per cent of its gross income on housing costs.

Questions You May Be Asked

To qualify for Community Housing (subsidized housing), you will need to have the following information available and feel comfortable discussing it:

- Your household's total gross monthly income
- How many people live in your household
- The building selections you make on the application
- Your age
- · Support services needed, if any
